

Who has it?

Suitable age: Preschool up

Prior knowledge required: None, but alphabet sounds helpful

Format: PDF

Pages: 11

Colour/Black and White: Colour

'Who has it?' is a card game which teaches (or revises) the alphabet sounds.

This game has been designed for three or more players (although you can play it with just two if you choose to).

To play, simply shuffle the cards and deal them out to the children. One child will pick up one of their cards and identify the sound on it. For example, Peter randomly picks up one of his cards and says the sound on the back: "c". Once he has said the sound Peter places the card into the middle of the group.

All of the children must then look through their cards until they find one which has a picture beginning* with that sound. The child can then flip over that card and say the sound on the back e.g. "i" and then place the card onto the pile in the middle of the group. The game continues in the same manner until one child gets rid of all of their cards. This child will be the winner.

* Except for the letter 'x' whose common sound happens at the end (or middle) of words.
